

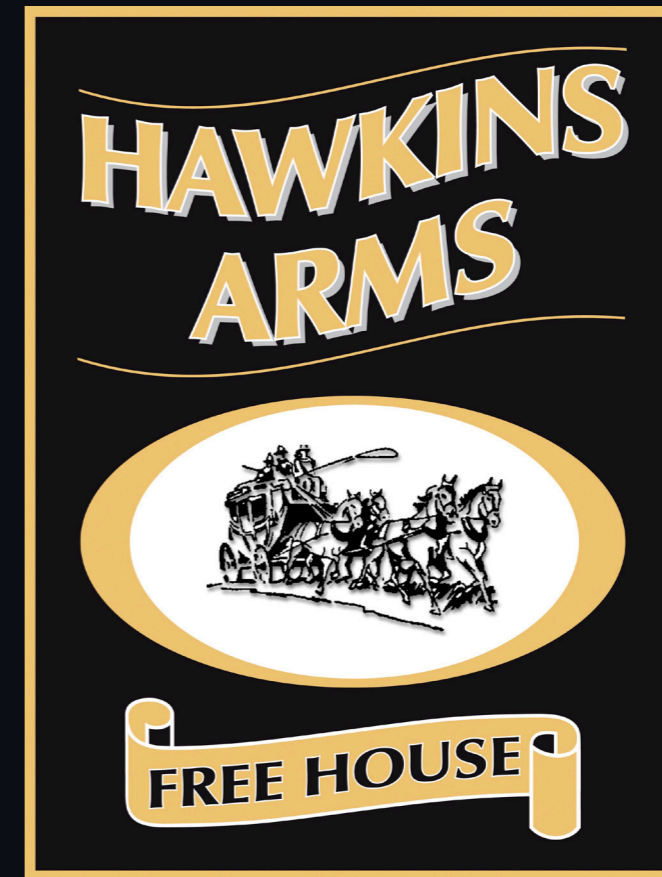

CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING

- 01. Prosecco, Borgo Sanleo, NV, Veneto, Italy**
Intense floral, fruity bouquet. A wonderfully fresh and well-balanced, appley palate with just a hint of delicate almond. (1) 11% vol

- 02. Villa Sandi Il Fresco Rosé NV, Veneto, Italy**
Fruity and flowery bouquet with delicate notes of golden apple. This rosé is dry, fresh and zesty with a harmonious summer fruit finish. (2) 11.5% vol

- 03. Laurent-Perrier La Cuvée Brut NV, Champagne, France**
In the top rank of Champagne houses, the style is light and elegant. Real finesse tops yeasty, fresh bread undertones, taut apple and citrus fruit. Complex, absolute purity. (1) 12% vol

WHITE WINE

- 04. Billycan Chardonnay 2017/18, South East Australia**
Australia has moved away from heavy, oaky, simple white wines and this Chardonnay shows their new improved style. Light and fresh with crisp green apple character. (2) 13% vol

- 05. Santa Helena Sauvignon Blanc 2018/19, Central Valley, Chile**
This classic Chilean style of Sauvignon Blanc is lively and lifted, with a herbal green pea leafiness and real freshness through the finish. (2) 12% vol

- 06. Soprano Pinot Grigio 2017/18, Pavia, Italy**
Crisp apple and soft white pear flavours. This wine is easy drinking with a lifted freshness. (1) 11.5% vol

- 07. Chablis Alain Geoffroy 2017/18, Burgundy, France**
Fragrant flowers, fruity aromas with sweet, suave scents. A pronounced mineral character enhances the fruit flavours. (1) 13% vol

- 08. Taringi Sauvignon Blanc 2018/19, Marlborough, New Zealand**
Distinctive Marlborough aromas leap out of the glass and continue to the palate - gooseberry, nettle, lime and passion fruit. A pleasingly crisp finish leaves you wanting more. (1) 12.5% vol

- 09. Sancerre Domaine Neveu 2017/18, Loire, France**
Classic wine from the historical home of Sauvignon. Not only does it have an elegant 'gunflint' minerality, but the grassy, gooseberry fruit carries through the citrus richness. (1) 12.5% vol

WINE GUIDE

White & Rosé wines are designated numbers 1 to 5 with 1 being the driest and 5 being the sweetest.

Red wines are designated letters A to E with A being the lightest and softest and E being the deepest and fullest with a concentrated flavour.

ROSÉ WINE

- 10. Les Vignerons Grenache Merlot Rosé 2017/18, Languedoc, South of France**
Pale in colour with golden hues. This refreshing lively wine offers intense flavours such as peach and citrus with floral hints. Crisp and zesty, the palate has excellent balance and an elegant finish. (2) 13% vol

- 11. Falling Petal Zinfandel Rosé 2017/18, California, USA**
Medium sweet rosé, displaying classic strawberry fruit flavours. (4) 10.5% vol

RED WINE

- 12. Villa Rosaura Merlot Reserva 2018/19, Central Valley, Chile**
A deep violet red wine with mature red fruit aromas of plum combined with spiced notes. On the palate, rich, velvety tannins, a medium body and a lasting finish. (C) 13% vol

- 13. Yallaroo Shiraz 2018/19, South East Australia**
This is a fresh, juicy, fruity Aussie Shiraz laden with black forest flavours. Delicious and easy drinking. (B) 13.5% vol

- 14. Urmeneta Cabernet Sauvignon 2017/18, Central Valley, Chile**
Dark, ruby colour, full of red fruit aromas, perfectly mixed with sweet vanilla and coconut notes. It has a fresh mouthfeel, medium body, soft tannins and a long, pleasant finish. (C) 13.5% vol

- 15. Cormoran Crianza 2015/16, Rioja, Spain**
Dark cherry red. Clean with intense ripe fruit, liquorice and toasted notes. This wine is rich and rounded in the mouth with a lovely long finish. (C) 14% vol

- 16. Tamari Malbec 2017/18, Mendoza, Argentina**
Soft red fruit notes with elegantly smooth tannins and a lingering finish. A great example of Argentina's hallmark red wine. (C) 12.5% vol

- 17. Old True Zin Zinfandel 2016/17, Puglia, Italy**
Fruity with notes of plums, cherry jam and tobacco; spicy with an aftertaste of cocoa, coffee and vanilla. Organic - tick, oak-aged - tick, Californian - oh no, this is Southern Italy at its most jovial. (D) 14% vol

- 18. Valmoissine Pinot Noir Louis Latour 2015/16, Côteaux du Verdon, South of France**
Valmoissine is the upland site of an ancient monastery, perfect for Pinot Noir. The proof is its fresh strawberry aroma and open flavours, the effect is of ripe softness. (B) 12% vol

- 19. Knightor Carpe Diem Red NV, Cornwall, England**
Lightly oaked, youthful and fresh. The nose is full of ripe berry characters such as cherry and strawberry, yet the Regent also provides it with crushed black pepper, spice and a little blackcurrant leaf. (B) 11.5% vol
